You will find a clear description of the pathway as we practise it: the five stages from first contact to twelve-month follow-up; the length of hospital stay by procedure; the fees and international insurance plans we accept; the languages spoken in the office; the contacts to begin.

**What this guide is not:** a medical opinion. No medical opinion can be given without an in-person consultation and a full review of your medical records. **What this guide does:** help you decide whether to reach out — and, if you do, know exactly what to expect.

## 02 · FOUR SPECIALTIES

# Four specialties, *one surgeon.*

The office receives international patients for the full clinical scope of the practice. It is a complete surgical pathway, not a counter for a single pathology. Each specialty is exercised at a level of expertise validated by training within the three leading French cancer institutions.

## Breast surgery

Benign lesions, at-risk lesions, breast cancer. Lumpectomy with oncoplasty, total or conservative mastectomy, prophylactic mastectomy for BRCA1/BRCA2 carriers, sentinel lymph node, axillary clearance.

## Gynaecological cancers

Cancers of the cervix, endometrium, ovary, fallopian tubes and vulva. Laparoscopic radical hysterectomy, salpingo-oophorectomy, conisation, trachelectomy, vulvar and vaginal surgery. Multidisciplinary tumour boards (MDT).

## Benign pelvic surgery

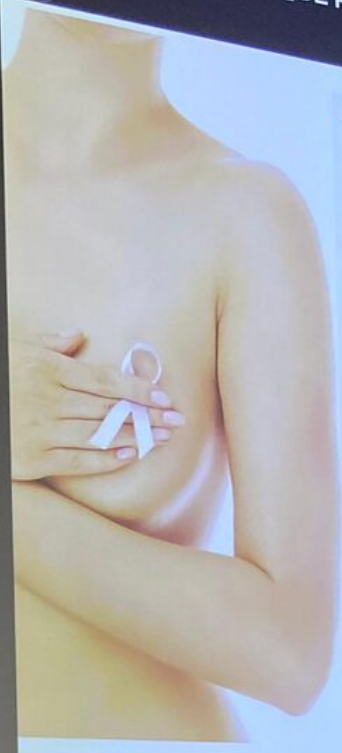
Uterine fibroids, ovarian cysts, hysteroscopies, conisations, labiaplasty. Laparoscopic hysterectomy for benign indications. Comprehensive management of non-oncological pelvic conditions.

## Breast reconstruction

Immediate or delayed reconstruction with implant or temporary prosthesis (expander), latissimus dorsi, lipofilling, flat closure. Expert opinion on DIEP and PAP flap reconstruction.

### 03 · WHY PARIS

# Why *Paris*?

France is among the world's leading countries for breast and gynaecological cancer outcomes. The **five-year breast cancer survival rate** is **88%**, comparable to the United Kingdom and the United States. Paris hosts three of the country's leading cancer institutions — these three institutions shaped **my training pathway**.

**In essence.** Paris is chosen by international patients for three reasons: (1) the surgical standards of the leading French institutions, brought into private practice; (2) the availability of multidisciplinary tumour boards (MDT) involving all specialties; (3) the privacy and continuity afforded by a single-surgeon model — direct WhatsApp access, teleconsultation follow-up after return home.

For international patients, the appeal is not the public hospital but the **private practice model**: one surgeon, one file, one conversation — from first contact to twelve-month follow-up.

- **Institut Curie** — Former Resident. World's first dedicated breast cancer institute, founded 1909.

- **Discretion.** By-appointment office in the 8<sup>th</sup> arrondissement, private clinic in Neuilly-sur-Seine.

## 04 · THE PATHWAY

# The *five-stage* pathway.

## 01 File review

24–48h

First contact via WhatsApp Business at +33 6 99 04 32 01 or by email. The dedicated coordinator acknowledges receipt within 24–48h and confirms the required documents: pathology reports, recent imaging, prior operative reports, copy of the passport.

## 02 Private video teleconsultation

20–40 min

Private video teleconsultation of 20 to 40 minutes on the secure Doctolib platform, in French or English. Dr Zeitoun personally reviews your imaging and file, presents the surgical options and answers questions **directly** — never delegated.

## 03 Quote & visa support letter

72h

Within 72 hours of the teleconsultation: (a) a detailed quote for the surgical procedure; (b) a support letter addressed to the French consulate, specifying dates of consultation, surgery and follow-up. No written care plan is issued: the therapeutic plan is discussed during the in-person consultation, prior to any intervention.

## 04 Travel to Paris & surgery

depending on  
procedure

The patient organises her own accommodation (hotel or residence) and transport. The office is within walking distance of the main Paris palace hotels in the 8<sup>th</sup> arrondissement. Surgery is performed at **Clinique Hartmann**, Neuilly-sur-Seine.

## 05 Long-distance follow-up

6w · 3m · 6m · 1y

Follow-up teleconsultations at 6 weeks, 3 months, 6 months and 1 year. For each, a written report is sent to your **referring physician** in your home country. If adjuvant treatment — chemotherapy or radiotherapy — is indicated, it is coordinated **in Paris, at Clinique Hartmann**.



*The written record prevails. Every consultation produces a signed report.*

## 05 · HOSPITAL STAY

## Length of *hospital stay* by procedure.

The length of hospital stay at Clinique Hartmann depends on the procedure performed. Most breast surgeries are performed as day-cases or with one to two overnight stays. Flap reconstructions and hysterectomies require a longer stay.

Procedure	Length of stay
Lumpectomy + sentinel lymph node	Day-case or 1 night
Mastectomy without reconstruction	1 to 2 nights
Mastectomy + implant reconstruction	1 to 2 nights
Flap reconstruction (DIEP, latissimus dorsi)	2 to 5 nights
Prophylactic mastectomy (BRCA)	1 to 2 nights
Hysterectomy	1 to 3 nights
Conisation	Day-case
Benign ovarian surgery (oophorectomy)	Day-case
Diagnostic or operative hysteroscopy	Day-case
Labiaplasty	Day-case

*The total length of stay in Paris (pre-operative consultation, surgery, post-operative follow-up before the return flight) is specified during consultation based on each patient's file.*

## 06 · FEES &amp; INSURANCE

## Fees, quote & *international insurance*.

Dr Zeitoun practises in **French Sector 2 non-OPTAM**. For international patients without French coverage, fees are billed in full and a personalised quote is issued after teleconsultation — **no quote is issued without prior review of the complete medical file**.

**The surgeon's quote covers the surgical procedure.** Clinic fees (Clinique Hartmann), anaesthesia, pathology and additional imaging are billed separately, directly by the relevant providers. Pre- and post-operative consultations and follow-up teleconsultations are billed separately, at the office's standard rate.

# Where consultations and procedures *take place.*

## CONSULTATIONS — Medical office

### 241 rue du Faubourg Saint-Honoré, 75008 Paris

Discreet office, by appointment only, in the heart of the 8<sup>th</sup> arrondissement, two minutes' walk from Le Bristol Paris and ten minutes from avenue Montaigne.

## PROCEDURES — Clinique Hartmann (ISHH)

### 26 boulevard Victor-Hugo, 92200 Neuilly-sur-Seine

Part of the Institut du Sein Henri Hartmann (ISHH) network — 15 minutes by car from central Paris. Private rooms, dedicated post-operative nursing, adapted catering on request, operating block dedicated to breast and gynaecological surgery.

## 08 · LANGUAGES & PRIVACY

# Languages, privacy & *confidentiality*.

*For international patients, discretion is the framework in which the entire pathway takes place.*

### LANGUAGES DIRECTLY WITH THE SURGEON

Consultations, correspondence, reports and quotes are issued in **French or English**. For any other language — Arabic, Russian, Mandarin, Spanish, Portuguese, German — **we recommend coming with your own translator**. The office does not organise interpretation.

### CONFIDENTIALITY AND MEDICAL SECRECY

By-appointment-only consultations · private rooms at Clinique Hartmann. All medical files are held under **French medical secrecy (art. L1110-4 CSP)** on HDS-certified infrastructure (Health Data Hosting). No third-party sharing without express written consent.

### CULTURAL ATTENTION

The office welcomes patients of all faiths and cultures. The presence of a chaperone or companion during consultations is available on the patient's request. No photographs, no public testimonials.

## 09 · FOLLOW-UP

## Long-distance *follow-up*.

Post-operative follow-up is an integral part of the international pathway. Teleconsultations are scheduled at **6 weeks, 3 months, 6 months and 1 year**.

For each consultation, a written report is sent to your **referring physician at home** — including the operative report, definitive pathology with immunohistochemistry, recommended adjuvant treatment plan and follow-up schedule.

**The same surgeon, every time.** Unlike institutional cancer centres where the surgical team may rotate, the single-surgeon private practice model means Dr Zeitoun personally responds to your messages, conducts the teleconsultations himself, and signs every letter — from first contact to twelve-month follow-up.

If adjuvant treatment — chemotherapy or radiotherapy — is indicated, it is coordinated **in Paris, at Clinique Hartmann**, with the oncologists and radiotherapists of the ISHH network.

**10 · FAQ**

## Frequently asked *questions*.

### *Can I obtain a support letter for my medical visa?*

**Yes.** Once the teleconsultation has taken place and the procedure is confirmed, a support letter addressed to the French consulate is issued within 24 hours, specifying the dates of consultation, surgery and follow-up.

### *Will Dr Zeitoun reply to me personally?*

**Yes.** The teleconsultation is conducted by Dr Zeitoun personally — never delegated. Between consultations, the coordinator manages logistical matters, but every clinical message is answered by the surgeon himself.

### *Which languages can I consult in?*

Dr Zeitoun speaks **French and English**. For any other language, **we recommend coming with your own translator**. The office does not organise interpretation.

### *How do I send my imaging and file?*

Documents are sent to the office via WhatsApp Business (+33 6 99 04 32 01) or by email. Imaging can be sent in DICOM format; reports as PDF in their original language. All files are held under French medical secrecy.

### *Can I come with a companion?*

**Yes.** A companion may be present during consultations. Clinique Hartmann offers private rooms allowing a loved one to be present during the hospital stay.

### *What documents should I prepare before the teleconsultation?*

Complete pathology report · recent imaging (mammography, ultrasound, MRI, PET scan as applicable) · prior operative reports · copy of the passport · genetic test results if already performed (BRCA in particular).

### *Where do adjuvant treatments take place?*

If chemotherapy or radiotherapy is indicated after the surgery, it is **coordinated in Paris, at Clinique Hartmann**, with the oncologists and radiotherapists of the ISHH network.
